

Clavister and the Bash bug

Clavister solutions not affected – here's what you need to know

You will have heard about the [GNU Bash Remote Code Execution Vulnerability \(CVE-2014-6271\)](#) also known as the Bash Bug or the Shellshock bug, which was recently revealed.

The good news:

Clavister products are not affected by this vulnerability as neither Bash or Linux is used in our products.

How to stay protected:

We've already released a signature to protect your network against this vulnerability (Exploit.bash.PoC.CVE-2014-6271).

To protect devices on your network vulnerable to this exploit, make sure [Intrusion Detection and Prevention \(IDP\)](#) is activated on Clavister firewalls and updated with the latest signature set.

If and when patches for other devices are available, update every device you have on the network.
